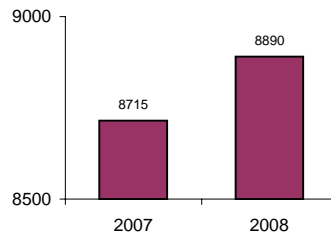

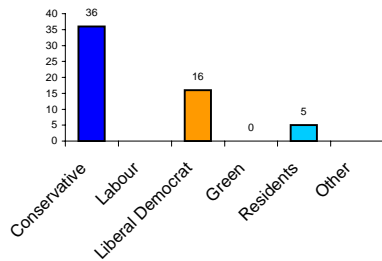

#### Distribution of Seats



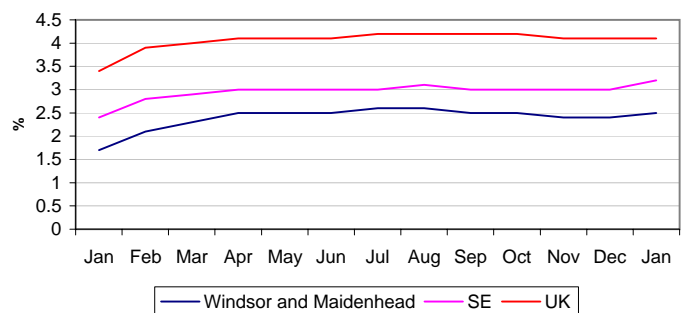

### Claimant Count Rate 2009 - 2010

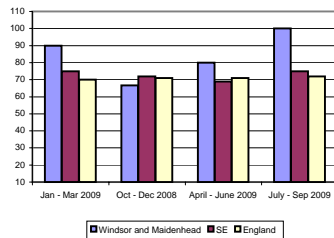

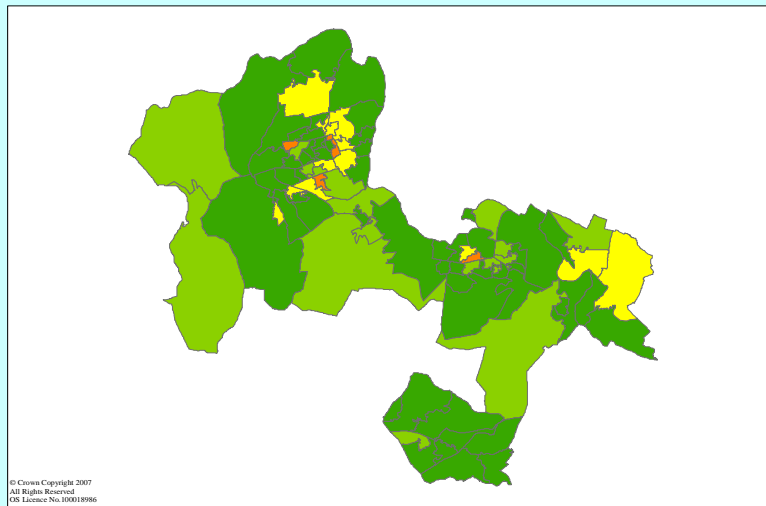
