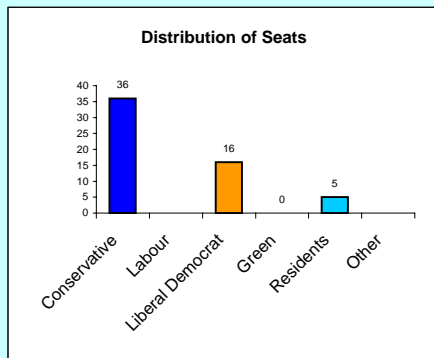

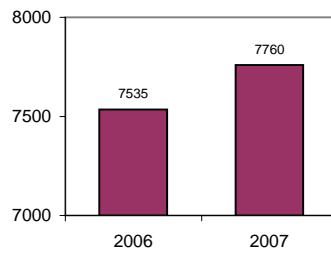

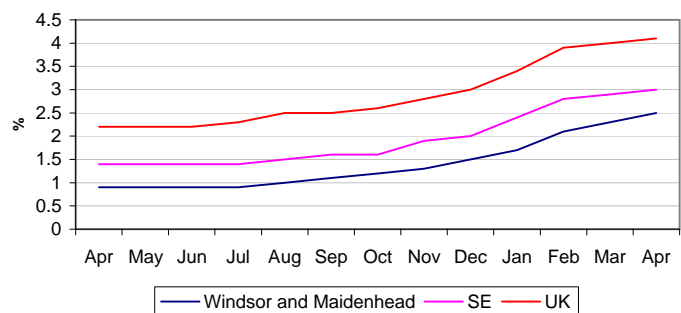

Claimant Count Rate 2008 - 2009

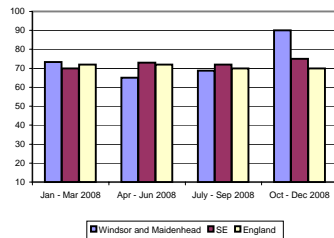

Percentage of Major planning Applications Determined within 13 Weeks



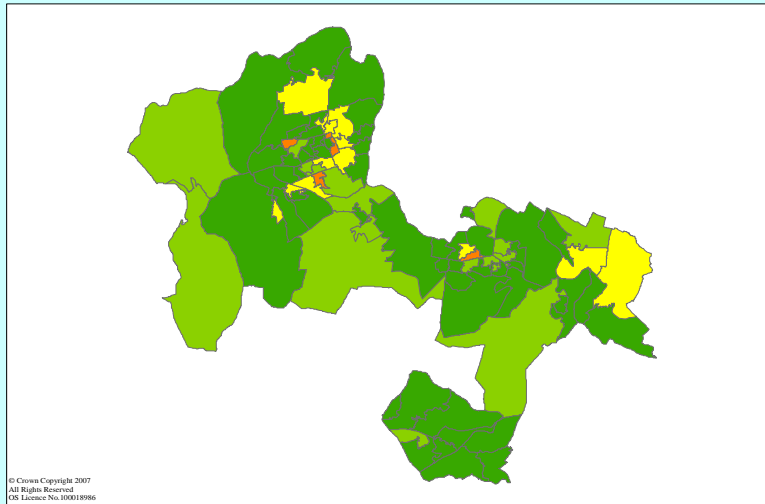
